SOUTH SHORE PBA50 PRO/AM 3-6-9 TOURNAMENT

FORMAT: One Pro and a maximum of 8 amateur bowlers will bowl on each pair of lanes on Monday, August 5. Amateur bowlers will bowl all 3 games on the same pair of lanes, teaming with 3 different professional bowlers (one for each game). Each amateur will bowl 3 games of 3-6-9 in which strikes will automatically be awarded in frames 3, 6, and 9. The total 3 games series, plus handicap for the amateur plus each of his/her professional partner's games will be added together to determine total scores. PBA50 bowlers will receive a minimum of 200 for each game.

HANDICAP: Handicap for the amateur bowler is 100% based on 220scratch. Pros bowl scratch.

ELIGIBILITY: Women and men are encouraged to participate. Entrants must be at least 18 to enter adult Pro/AM. Entrants must be at least 50 to bowl in the Senior Pro/AM. Senior bowlers must declare what division they are bowling in, Senior or Adult. Division B is for Boys, ages 18 & under, Division G is for Girls, ages 18 & under.

AVERAGES: Bowlers must use their highest 2023/24 verifiable average. Bowlers with no average will compete scratch. Proving and presenting an accurate and verifiable average is the responsibility of each entrant. If a bowler enters the tournament with a submitted average higher than his/her actual average, submitted average will be used as the official entering average. If a bowler submits an average lower than his/her actual average, the bowler will be automatically disqualified.

ADULT and SENIOR PRIZES: First place adult will receive a cash prize of \$1,200, based on 300 entries. First place senior will receive a cash prize of \$600, based on 150 entries. At least 1 in 10 will cash. Bowlers may re-enter but cash only once.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE: Questions not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee. Tournament Committee has the right to reject any entry. Entries close 5 minutes before each squad's published start time. No changes will be made in schedule times except in case of emergency.
